JLT Paintball Field Rules

1. Must be 10 years old. Every one fills out a waiver. Minors must have parent or legal guardian's signature. You are to fill out a waiver each year.
2. No foul language, fighting, alcohol or drugs. No bullying. Don't shoot safety signs. Don't argue with refs. Always be respectful.
3. NEVER lift or remove mask while on the field. Always have barrel blocker on and secure before leaving field. All goggles must meet A.S.T.M. specifications.
4. Radar your marker at 285 feet per second. 265 is recommended. No more than 14 balls fired per second.
5. We don't count guns, hoppers or tanks. Paint must break on you, your mask or pods. Paint must be at least a quarter size to be out. We play by the honor system. When hit, put yourself out.
6. If you are closer than 20 feet, call surrender. The opponent has 1-2 seconds to surrender. If opponent attempts to flee you may shoot. Opponent cannot shoot till there is a 20 ft. separation.
7. When charging a bunker, the 20 ft. rule does not apply. Make contact with the bunker and the opponent using it for cover is out.
8. No blind shooting around sides of the bunker. Shoot through holes head size or larger.
No tanking.
9. When hit, take cover at bunker. Put the safety on, put barrel blocker on. Hold gun high and leave field quickly.
10. Don't shoot players with barrel blockers in place and guns held up, when they are leaving the field. Either team may shoot a player once when leaving the field without BBD in place. Don't overshoot. When opponent is hit, stop shooting.
11. Out of paint, CO2, or air, you are out. Leave the field, no talking. River's on or off.
12. JLT Field paint ONLY. No carry on paint. By your support in purchasing paint and equipment, JLT is able to keep this field open. Thank-you.
